My work is both scholarly & political, aiming to strengthen research & education that tackles complex societal & environmental problems. In developing Integration & Implementation Sciences (i2S) I aim to connect ITD with systems thinking, action research, team science & more. I curate the popular i2Insights blog & repository. I am a founding member of the ITD-Alliance & am active in 2 working groups. I am also a founding member of NITRO-Oceania, for which I have lead submissions promoting ITD in research policy enquiries by the Australian government & international organisations.



Goals if elected president, including main strategic areas to pursue during presidency

My aim is to work with the leadership board, executive secretary, working groups, members & others to strengthen the ability of the ITD-Alliance to be a vehicle that advocates for, celebrates, enables, supports & shares global activities in ITD & associated areas. There is much to be done &, given that we are essentially volunteers with minimal funding, it is important not to dissipate our efforts.

My primary focus would therefore be on promotion & communication, along with ensuring that we function as a truly global alliance. This includes actively seeking opportunities to promote ITD & associated activities in research policy, funding & organisational fora; advancing best practice in asynchronous online meetings; providing regular informative updates to members; maintaining an engaging website; developing operational protocols; & highlighting the ITD24 conference.

I see these activities as essential to increasing the membership & funding base to ensure long-term viability. I would also look to increasing the number of & strengthening the working groups, as well as encouraging focused activities led by members of the leadership board & the wider membership.
