Report and video from Toolkits & Methods Meet & Greet event, 17 January 2025





It introduces different synthesis stages, methods and procedures and discusses challenges inherent in such collaborative processes.

Seeking essays on "Role of transdisciplinarity as a scientific and cultural approach in the prevention of global conflicts of modern civilization"

The Institute of Transdisciplinary Technologies (ITT, Russia) (http://www.td-science.ru) and the International Center for Transdisciplinary Research (CIRET, France) (http://ciret-transdisciplinarity.org) are organising a symposium of collected essays to determine the readiness of modern transdisciplinarity to participate in rethinking and solving the problems of sustainable development of society, and to determine the scientific and cultural potential of modern transdisciplinarity for the prevention of global conflicts, as one of the conditions for the formation of sustainable development of society.

Participants are invited to submit responses to a series of discussion questions by email (see symposium details and procedures). The editorial committee will compile a report, including participant responses, which will be available on the ITT and CIRET websites. The symposium will also be submitted for publication by a scientific publishing house.


47th Association for Interdisciplinary Studies Conference (AIS25), University of Oulu, Oulu, Finland, June 4-6, 2025, Keynote speakers update

The University of Oulu and Oulu University of Applied Sciences are hosting the <u>47th Association for Interdisciplinary Studies Conference (AIS25)</u> at the Linnanmaa campus, Oulu, Finland, in June 4-6, 2025.

Keynote speakers: ITD Alliance Member Rick Szostak, Professor Emeritus of Economics at the University of Alberta, Canada, has been announced as a closing plenary keynote speaker. Two other ITD Alliance members are also confirmed keynote speakers: ITD Alliance President, Gabriele Bammer, and Biannca Vienni-Baptista of the Transdisciplinarity Lab, ETH Zürich – a founding institutional member.

New initiative aimed at increasing understanding between researchers and policy

A new initiative aimed at increasing understanding between researchers and policy makers is by the UK Economic and Social Research Council. This is a funding call for the development and expansion of UK-wide policy to research (P2R) infrastructure, facilitating direct connections between public and civil servants and research organisations. This infrastructure will enable policymakers to build skills and understanding of research, evidence and data in policy development by engaging in relevant activities in an academic setting, including professional development, training, immersive workshops, placements, and networking. Call for Contributions, Special Session on Transdisciplinarity in and for Sustainability Transitions, International Sustainability Transitions (IST) Conference 2025, 24-26 June 2025, Lisbon, Portugal

In the face of pressing climate and sustainability challenges, this year's International Sustainability Transitions (IST) Conference 2025 focuses on navigating the tensions, trade-offs, and dilemmas inherent in driving the structural changes needed for sustainability transitions. The special session "Transdisciplinarity in and for Transitions" will critically explore how transdisciplinary approaches can help address these complexities while also examining the conflicts, tensions, and trade-offs that emerge in processes of knowledge co-production for societal change. The special session welcomes theoretical, empirical, and methodological contributions that go beyond additive models of knowledge integration.
