Description

As the leadership of universities and related organisations increasingly embraces transdisciplinarity in research and teaching as a way of tackling complex societal and environmental problems, what does it mean for those on the ground who are tasked with introducing transdisciplinary approaches? Adelaide University in Australia (which is newly established from an amalgamation of the University of South Australia and the University of Adelaide) and Te Kunenga ki Pūrehuroa Massey University of New Zealand are leading institutions addressing these challenges. Allan O'Connor and Allanah Ryan are heading up the change processes and have rich experience to share. They will make brief scene-setting presentations about their university's context and approach to transdisciplinarity, what their institutions "have going for them," and the main challenges, along with how they are addressing them. They will then engage in a dialogue, which will be broadened out to include the audience.



Moderation will be by Gabriele Bammer, President of the Global Alliance for Interand Transdisciplinarity (ITD Alliance). This hour-long webinar will be followed by a 30-minute open discussion – a Talanoa – where you can connect with others across Oceania who are passionate about inter- and transdisciplinarity.

Allan O'Connor is Professor of Enterprise Dynamics at the at the University of South Australia. Allan was independently recognised in 2020, 2021, and 2022 by The Australian newspaper as a leader in the field of entrepreneurship and innovation research. Allan teaches in and contributes leadership for the undergraduate Bachelor of Business (Innovation and Entrepreneurship) program. Allan has co-authored Entrepreneurship: Theory, Process and Practice, contributing to the 3rd, 4th and 5th editions. Currently, as part of the merger activities between UniSA (the University of South Australia) and the University of Adelaide, and the formation of Adelaide University, Allan is leading the development of one of six core courses for whole of university delivery, in the domain area of Entrepreneurship and Design Thinking. <u>Online profile</u>.

Allanah Ryan is Associate Director Sustainability at Te Kunenga ki Pūrehuroa Massey University. She is co-lead for a project to develop a new university-wide transdisciplinary qualification at Massey. Previous roles as an academic and Head of School of a large multi-disciplinary social science School have included contributions to a report on 'Catalysing Interdisciplinary Research at Massey University' (2017) and supporting the development of cross-disciplinary teaching within the School of People, Environment and Planning.
